### Dave Johnston bio

Dave started growing Bromeliads in 1985 and joined the Bromeliad Guild of Tampa Bay (now known as the Bromeliad & Tropical Plant Society of Tampa) shortly thereafter. He was president of the Tampa club five times and served every position there except for secretary. Dave also was a representative to the Florida Council of Bromeliad Societies (FCBS).

Dave joined the Florida West Coast Bromeliad Society in the late 1980's where he was president twice as well as being a director.

Dave's Bromeliad speaking began over 20 years ago as he was the in-house speaker on Bromeliads for Sunken Gardens in St. Petersburg for over a decade. Dave has given numerous presentations to Bromeliad societies over the last several years.

Dave launched Bromeliads Galore as a collector's nursery in 1990. He had over 2,000 different species and hybrids, but has since cut back to only over 1,000 different Bromeliads!
