### **August Plant Sale**

The **Annual Fall Plant Sale** will be on August 19-20, 2023. We will need volunteers for the many roles including cashiers, tag takers, customer helpers (to help buyers take plants to their cars), and tropical plant experts to answer customer questions.

Every member qualifies as a *tropical plant expert* to some degree and plant buyers will greatly value your advice. One of the most frequent comments we receive from plant buyers is how they love the information they get from our members at the plant sales.

On Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup>, plant setup commences at 11 AM and ends at 3:30 PM. **There will then be a Presale for Members Only from 4 to 6 PM on that Friday.** Members will be able to shop early without the crowds and take their new plants home on Friday.
