We will have the same wide aisles and controlled access (up to 45 customers at one time) that worked so well at recent plant sales. And we will have outside vendors selling orchid supplies and native plants.

Be sure to wear your SBTPS logo t-shirts or polo shirts if you have one to the plant sale. It will make it easy for our customers to find someone knowledgeable to answer their questions.

August Plant Sale

The Annual Fall Plant Sale will be on August 16-17, 2025. We will need volunteers for the many roles including cashiers, tag takers, customer helpers (to help buyers take plants to their cars), and tropical plant experts to answer customer questions.

Every member qualifies as a *tropical plant expert* to some degree and plant buyers will greatly value your advice. One of the most frequent comments we receive from plant buyers is how they love the information they get from our members at the plant sales.

Plant setup is on Friday before the weekend sale. Setup will commence at 11 AM and end at 3:30 PM. There will be a Presale for Members Only on Friday, August 15th from 4 to 6 PM. You will be able to shop early without the crowds and take your new plants home on Friday.

2025 Bromeliad Extravaganza

The SBTPS will host the **2025 Bromeliad Extravaganza** on September 26-27, 2025 at the Ramada Gateway hotel in Kissimmee. The hotel rate is only \$85.80 plus tax if you book the hotel before August 27th.

The registration fee of \$125 includes a Friday dinner and Saturday banquet, early admission to the biggest Bromeliad sale in Florida this year and admission to the seminars with three speakers (**Leonardo Versieux** from Brazil, **Bryan Windham** from Louisiana, and **Dennis Cathcart** from Florida). Access to the seminars will be limited to registrants. Registration also includes a Conference Logo bag with a \$10 plant sale coupon (*if you register by the end of August*), a free ticket to enter in a drawing for extra-early access to the plant sale on Friday evening, and access to several gardens of local Bromeliad society members early Sunday afternoon. *Only the Saturday plant sale and evening rare plant auction will be open to the public*.
