Bryan started collecting Bromeliads in 1997. The first one he bought was at a craft fair he attended. It was a flashy Vriesea mounted on a piece of cypress driftwood. He joined the River Ridge Bromeliad Society where he was president for 20 consecutive years. Over the years he has made many terrestrial hybrids. His curiosity got the best of him and he started making bigenerics: Sincoraechmeas, Dyckliriums, Dyckcohnias, Pucohnias, Canmeas and more. He has also made many Aechmea hybrids. Bryan grows many other plants. He has 5000 square feet of greenhouses.
